PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear brothers and sisters,

We cannot blame everything on Satan - "the devil made me do it" - as God has given us a rational mind and the free will to choose. However, we must not forget or lose sight that this enemy uses a lot of subtle, subconscious subterfuge to employ us as his pawns. How often does anger, fear, surprise catch us off-guard and we find ourselves reacting quickly and rashly when something happens, frequently making the situation worse than it had to be?

His tactics include the four (D)'s for starters: deception, discouragement, distraction, and division. We have seen significant confusion as so many are confused in the area of identity; and not only gender dysphoria, but people lose sight of their identity in Jesus Christ. This deception wounds a person to the core and this then affects the community.

The LGBTQ+ culture has magnified this situation along with partisan politics, allowing the deception to magnify the division in our nation and world. And, this is his distraction: to keep our minds off more important topics. Dividing us keeps us busy with emotions of what sides to take; should we sympathize; how do we address our own family members with confusion. We are distracted from the focus of God's Will and acting on our true identity and building up the body of Christ, the Church. Focusing more on our true identity, we would witness divisions healing and better unity as we focus on more important - and truthful - matters.

It is important that parents have conversations of substance with their children on a regular basis. Our youth hear whispers that discourage them: "You are too fat"; "you are not smart enough"; "you don't belong." They need loving voices that drown out those deceptive voices that they think are their own thoughts. And how often do adults still hear such discouraging thoughts?
