LA ASCENSION DEL SEÑOR Lc 24,46-53

Hoy la Palabra nos hace como un sencillo resumen de los grandes misterios de nuestra fe. Nos enuncia que el Mesías tenía que morir, que resucitaría al tercer día y que en su nombre hay que anunciar a todas las naciones que se conviertan a Dios. Nunca en tan pocas líneas se dijo tanto. Muerte y resurrección consiguieron el perdón de los pecados. La Ascensión es el principio y el fundamento de la misión. Una misión que consiste fundamentalmente en elevar la realidad, liberándola del egoísmo, de la violencia, de la mentira interesada, de la superficialidad. La fiesta de hoy nos invita a levantar nuestros ojos, a mirar al cielo en un intento de recuperar para nuestra vida la dosis de trascendencia y esperanza necesaria para no sucumbir a la tentación de un horizontalismo materialista; para dotar a la existencia de motivos válidos y permanentes más allá de la provisoriedad y el oportunismo utilitarista. La Ascensión de Jesús no es una ascensión local, no es pasar de un espacio a otro. Es una intensificación de la presencia del Señor en nuestra realidad sabiendo que no nos abandona ni después de resucitado. Los discípulos no le vieron salir del sepulcro porque la resurrección podía probarse mediante la evidencia de contemplarlo vivo después de su muerte, más tuvieron la experiencia de verlo ascender a los cielos. De la misma manera nosotros, sin dejar de mirar al Cielo, ¡debemos actuar! ¡Hay mucho por hacer! ¡Hay mucho que cambiar, en mí mismo y a mi alrededor! ¡Muchos dependen de mí! ¡Es todo un mundo el que hay que transformar desde sus cimientos! Y el Señor nos promete la fuerza de su Espíritu para que seamos hoy sus apóstoles que anuncien su Evangelio a tiempo y destiempo, un pequeño ejército, que con la fuerza de su Amor trabajemos incansablemente por transformar el mundo en que vivimos, para hacerlo más humano, más fraterno, más reconciliado, según el Evangelio de Jesucristo y con la fuerza de su gracia, sin la cual nada podemos. Así hemos de vivir día a día este dinamismo: sin dejar de mirar siempre hacia allí donde Cristo está glorioso, con la esperanza firme y el ardiente anhelo de poder participar un día de su misma gloria.

Again - A Farmer & Baker Push Back Religious Hostility Legally known as "religious animus," religious hostility is once again trying to prevent small businesses from earning a living when the business owners practice their deeply held religious beliefs.


* Michigan fruit farmer, Steve Tennes, had been banned from selling his produce at the local farmers market because of his religious beliefs hosting only traditional marriages on his farm, 22 miles away. In 2017, a judge granted a temporary order allowing Tennes to return to the farmers market. Now, in 2019, his attorney is requesting that the city permanently lift the ban. She said, "All Americans should be free to live and speak according to their deeply held religious beliefs without fear of government punishment."

* Last year, the U.S. Supreme Court ruled 7-2 in favor of Colorado baker, Jack Phillips, when he declined to bake a wedding cake for a same-sex couple since using his artistic talent to celebrate this event conflicted with his religious beliefs. This year, a second case was brought involving a complaint after he declined to make a specialized cake for a transgender transition. On March 5, the CO commission dropped its case against Phillips provided he withdraw his lawsuit against the state for "harassment."

"I have and will always serve everyone who comes into my shop; I simply can't celebrate events or express messages that conflict with my religious beliefs," said Phillips.
