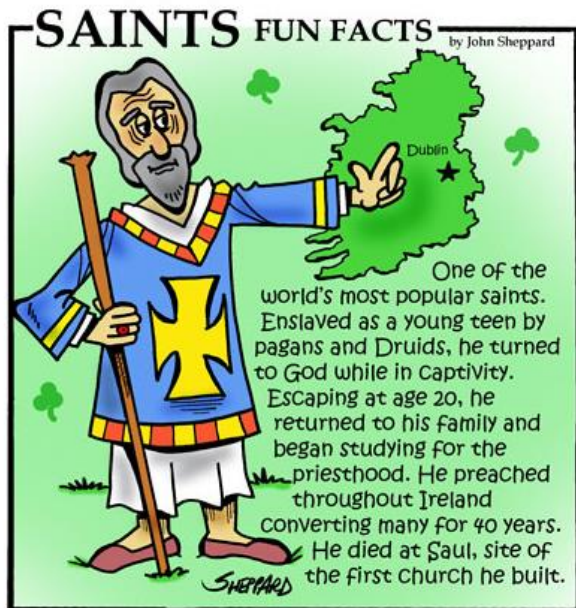

X MARKS THE SPOT

(Reflections: Psalm 119:97-105 Habakkuk 2:1-4)

Nails are very useful things. Sometimes they are used for marking and guiding. A carpenter may tap a nail into a place he wants to remember, or drive one lightly through a panel to mark the location of a wall stud. Nails can be used to tack a piece into place so that it won't move until final assembly is possible. And the ever-popular hobby of "string art" uses nails as the points from which strings are stretched to form artistic patterns.

The Cross of Jesus Christ to which he was nailed for you also serves this kind of function: to mark the place where your sins were taken away, and to guide the way you live.

One great Christian hymn says it well:
 Oh, that the Lord would guide my ways
 To keep his statutes still?
 Oh, That my God would grant me grace
 To know and do his will!
