Mateo 25,31-46

Con la solemnidad de Cristo Rey llegamos al final del año litúrgico. El domingo próximo será el primero del Adviento. El fin de un año y el principio del otro nos hacen tomar conciencia de la brevedad del tiempo y de una historia que llegara a su termino; de una historia que camina hacia el punto final que es Cristo. Su Reino se va abriendo paso en la historia y es para toda la humanidad. Al final de la historia entregara al Padre su reino de amor, de justicia y de paz, para que Dios sea todo en todas las cosas. Por eso todo camina hacia El y todo será transformado por El. Un amor que hoy hace necesario que trabajemos para: que todo el mundo tenga un empleo justamente retribuido y así pueda vivir dignamente, que en la sociedad se respeten los derechos humanos, que haya programas de salud a los que todos tengan acceso, que se evite todo lo que es opresión y discriminación. Al termino de nuestra existencia seremos examinado por Cristo en el Amor.
