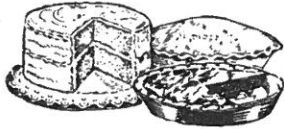

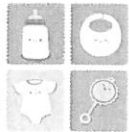

- Photo ID
- Birth Certificate or Medicaid Cards for the children
- Last 4 numbers of social security for everyone in the family
- Legal Custody Papers for any children where you are not listed as the parent on the birth certificate
- Proof of Income for ALL those living in your household (Pay stubs, Food Stamps, Social Security benefits, Disability)
- Proof of Expenses: all bills for the past month Rent, mortgage, lights, water, gas, sanitation, telephone, cable, car payments, insurance, medical, childcare, loans

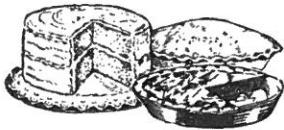
