Fr. Joe McDonough – 50th Anniversary

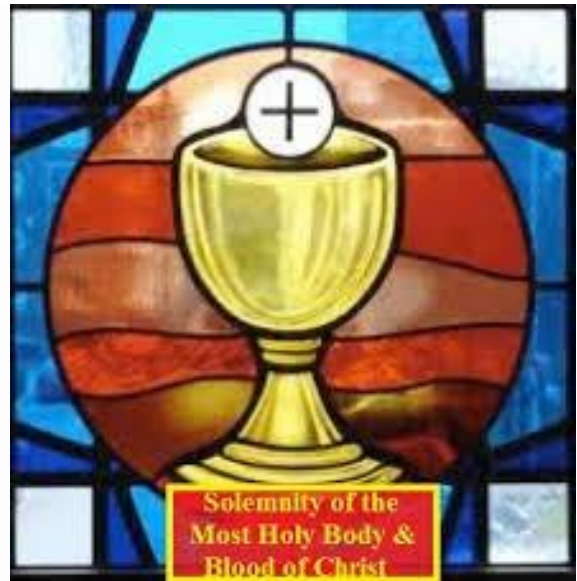

'Tis the Season for GRADUATIONS! And, YES... Student Speakers May Pray! Colorado Mesa University has reversed its requirement that graduation speeches must be devoid of religious references after Alliance Defending Freedom (ADF) contacted them on behalf of a student who was told she needed to keep comments about Christ out of her planned speech. University officials had told the graduate to “take out the last section where you state that you find comfort in Jesus’ words and cite a Bible verse.” “It is ... well established law (U.S. Supreme Court) that university officials cannot silence speech simply because it expresses a particular viewpoint, including a religious one,” wrote an ADF attorney. “When they were confronted with what the law required, they quickly backtracked and allowed the student to speak freely.” According to the U.S. Department of Education Guidelines: “Students can include religious content, including prayer, in their graduation speeches as long as ... the control over the content of each address is left to the students, and not the school.” (coloradomesa.edu/adflegal.org/5/10/18; christiannews.net/5/11/18; frc.org/5/14/18) “I share the concern and frustration that many Americans feel about situations where the protections accorded by the First Amendment are not recognized or understood.
