Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

Me dirijo a ustedes en relación con la propagación continua del virus COVID-19 en Carolina del Sur. Según los Centros de Control de Enfermedades (CDC), la variante delta se contrae más fácil y rápidamente que otras variantes. El número de casos está aumentando y provoca más hospitalizaciones y potencialmente más muertes. Está ejerciendo una presión sobre los recursos de atención médica.

**He escrito a vuestros pastores para recomendar que se usen máscaras durante las Misas, y que tomemos la Comunión en la mano, para que podamos seguir celebrando el culto juntos.**

Además, recomiendo encarecidamente que todas las personas que sean elegibles se vacunen.

La Congregación para la Doctrina de la Fe emitió una guía sobre las vacunas COVID-19 que determina que es moralmente lícito y no está prohibido que los católicos sean vacunados contra el virus.

Por favor, continúen respetando las ordenanzas y directivas locales de los CDC y de los funcionarios del gobierno de Carolina del Sur, y tomen precauciones tanto como sea posible para que cada uno de nosotros pueda hacer su parte para poner fin a esta terrible enfermedad.

Sé que estos son tiempos difíciles, y por eso continúo orando por ustedes y sus familias.

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I write to you concerning the continuing spread of the COVID-19 virus in South Carolina. According to the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), the delta variant is contracted more easily and rapidly than other variants. The number of cases is increasing and leading to more hospitalizations and potentially more deaths. It is placing a strain on healthcare resources.

**I have written to your pastors to recommend that masks be worn during Masses, and that we take Communion in the hand, so that we are able to continue worshipping together.** Also, I strongly recommend that everyone who is eligible get vaccinated.

The Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith issued guidance on COVID-19 vaccines determining that it is morally licit, that is, lawful and not forbidden, for Catholics to be vaccinated against the virus.

Please continue to respect local ordinances and directives from the CDC and South Carolina government officials, and take precautions as much as possible so that we may each do our part to end this terrible disease.

I know that these are difficult times, and so I continue to pray for you and your families.
