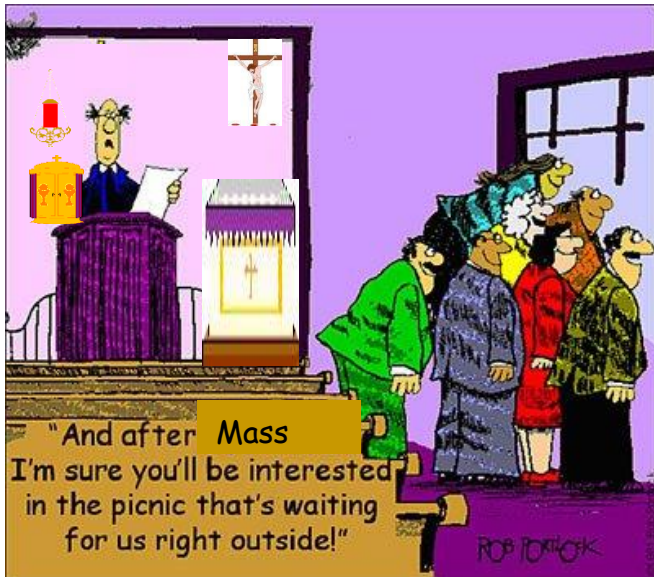

**Sorting of Toys:** Volunteers will be needed to help sort, count and categorize incoming toys at the toy shop.

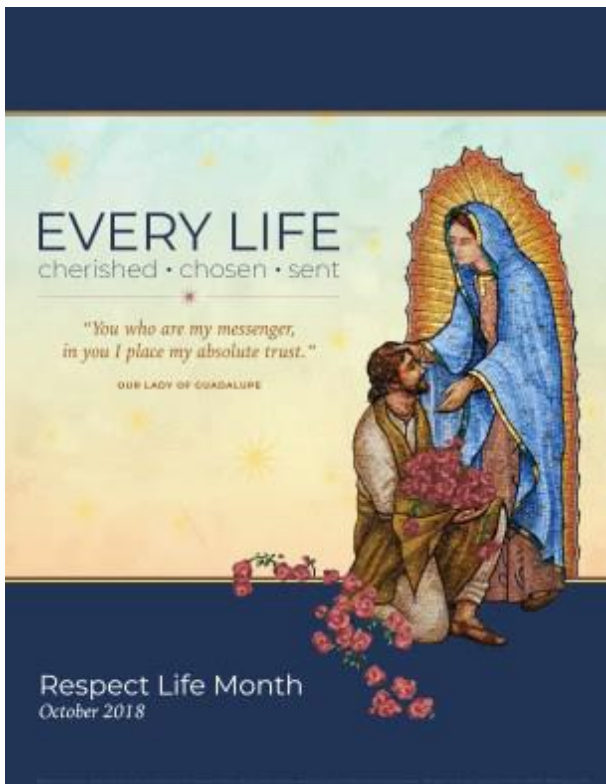
