Catholic Charities Pee Dee's Christmas Assistance 2019 is available to Horry County families with children under the age of 18 years old.

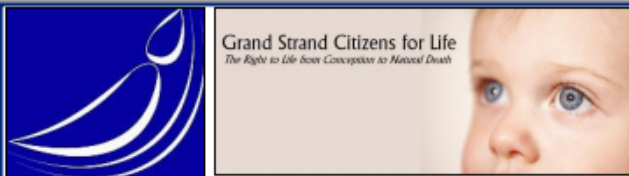
Registration is required for this assistance.

Each family seeking assistance **MUST** bring the following items to their appointment:

- ◆ Photo ID
- ◆ Birth Certificate or Medicaid Cards for the children
- ◆ Last 4 numbers of social security for everyone in the family
- ◆ Legal Custody Papers for any children where you are not listed as the parent on the birth certificate
- ◆ Proof of Income for ALL those living in your household
Pay stubs, Food Stamps, Social Security benefits, Disability
- ◆ Proof of Expenses: all bills for the past month Rent, mortgage, lights, water, gas, sanitation, telephone, cable, car payments, insurance, medical, child care, loans.

Christmas Assistance will only be available to families who are pre-registered and have an appointment the day of the event!

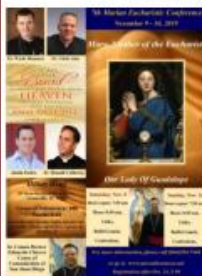
GRAND STRAND CITIZENS FOR LIFE CONFERENCE SEPTEMBER 28, 2019
