## PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear brothers and sisters,

As I complete my last week of my sabbatical, I continue to recognize the importance of Truth and its fullness. I am reminded of a situation I had as a newly ordained priest. I woke up with my arm tingling, which did not stop for weeks. I went to my GP, who prescribed Ibuprofen, but then referred me to an orthopedic, who referred me to a neurologist, who made things worse. None of them were open to chiropractic medicine. Yes, I know that some of them may be questionable, but so are many doctors. My point here is that some doctors are closed to other forms of caring for their patients: it is all about "what I can do for."



When I teach sacramental preparation, I try to impress upon parents that they, rather than their children, need to have a good faith formation. As humans, we need to develop physical (body), intellectual (mind), emotional (spirit), and spiritual (soul) dimensions of ourselves. Failing to provide sufficient faith formation is like removing one of the four legs of a chair.

Here, those who have been working with me on issues have seemingly lost sight of the spiritual side as they focus on the psyche, whose industry is not always in proper alignment with Catholic Christian teaching. Like some philosophies, various writers develop their hypotheses to support their agendas. However, losing sight of Jesus Christ, who is "the Way, the Truth, and the Life," loses credibility and substance. Truth and love are essential, as they are of God; opinions, however, are not always of God. May we learn the importance of and stay close to the Truth.

While this Feast is a relatively new one, its history - and the mystery behind it - dates back to the earliest centuries of Christianity. Church Tradition holds that when Mary's earthly life ended, God assumed her, body and soul, into Heaven. This dogma of her Assumption - also called the "Dormition of Mary" - is rooted in the early centuries of the Church. The belief in her Assumption was widely-held and a frequent meditation in the writings of saints; however, it was not defined officially until the past century. Scripturally, Psalm 16 prepares us that God would not allow His beloved one - most likely about Jesus but also Mary who is His "favored one" - to suffer decay in the tomb (v. 9-11).

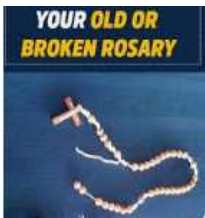

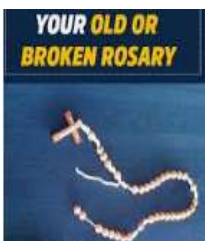
