### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Due to the virulent outbreak of influenza, we will suspend the distribution of Holy Communion under both kinds until the outbreak has abated. For the sake of caution, we will suspend temporarily the distribution of the Precious Blood of Christ at the Eucharist in order to prevent the spread of disease. Keep in mind that even when Holy Communion is distributed under the form of bread alone, the communicant still receives the Lord entirely, in His Body, Blood, soul and divinity. The Shaking of Hands at the Sign of Peace has also been suspended until further notice.
