 He was ordained Priest Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico on March 22, 1913.  
 He served as pastor in Tecolotlán, Jalisco, México, during the Religious persecution in México.  
 On June 26, 1927 it was murdered, because of his love to Jesus Christ.  
 He was canonized on May 21, 2000, by Pope John Paul II, with his 24 companions in martyrdom.
