Summer greetings!

As I leave to begin my 3-week sabbatical, I encourage everyone to consider taking a retreat. A retreat is not necessarily a vacation. Often, when we return from a vacation, we feel the need to rest afterwards. A retreat seeks to re-focus us, to recharge us, to re-enthuse (*en theos* means to be filled with God). Retreats do not burden us with activities; they provide discipline for prayer, reading, and rest in the peace of Jesus Christ.

To be honest, I am here as a result of asking for a sabbatical. A priest going on sabbatical sets off a domino effect, typically for a 6-month period. Canon Law recommends that priests take a sabbatical every seven years or so; we are notorious for not doing so. In at least 18 of my 22 years as a priest, I have rarely taken my full allotted vacation time, and my last assignment was quite busy. I needed to get away, especially after two particular deaths in 2024, and get re-focused and primarily "en theos'ed".

We cannot expect to handle the numerous curves and fastballs that this world throws at us and think that one day a week on the Christian Sabbath is enough to keep us on the right path. Parents, your vacations still have you working as you entertain your children. Families should consider going on retreats, as they provide an opportunity for someone to teach them how to pray together and develop a shared discipline. I will pray for y'all while I am gone; please keep me in your prayers as well!
