- ◆ Photo ID
- ◆ Birth Certificate or Medicaid Cards for the children
- ◆ Last 4 numbers of social security for everyone in the family
- ◆ Legal Custody Papers for any children where you are not listed as the parent on the birth certificate
- ◆ Proof of Income for ALL those living in your household  
Pay stubs, Food Stamps, Social Security benefits, Disability
- ◆ Proof of Expenses: all bills for the past month Rent, mortgage, lights, water, gas, sanitation, telephone, cable, car payments, insurance, medical, child care, loans.

Christmas Assistance will only be available to families who are pre-registered and have an appointment the day of the event!
