Lent begins Ash Wednesday, February 26th

Abstinence: All persons who have completed their fourteenth year are bound by the law of abstinence.

The law of abstinence forbids the eating of meat and foods prepared with meat or meat by-products.

Fast: The law of fast means that adults are bound to fast from the day after their eighteenth birthday until the end of the day of the fifty-ninth birthday.

The law of fast allows only one full meal and two lighter meals in the course of a day, and prohibits eating between meals.

In the United States, Ash Wednesday (February 26, 2020) and Good Friday (April 10, 2020) are days of fast and abstinence. All other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence only.

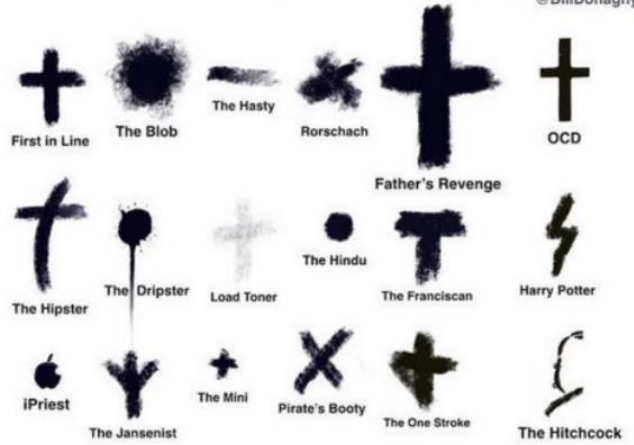
